Statement for the Rules & regulations'2021 of the Full-time Diploma Engineering Courses regarding Students enrolled through Lateral Entry Scheme:

As per AICTE guidelines 10th + (2 years ITI) with appropriate Trade in that order shall be eligible for admission to Second Year Diploma Course(s) of appropriate Programme. Mapping of ITI trades with corresponding Diploma Engineering Programmes shall be as follows:

Education (Higher) Department, Government of Tripura has issued a circular for implementing Lateral Entry Scheme for admission of 2-year ITI pass-out candidates into the Diploma Engineering courses running in all Government-run Polytechnic Institutes of Tripura.

The rules & regulations for Lateral Entry Scheme will be same as for Full time 3 years Diploma Engineering Courses, with the following exceptions & changes:

- 1) The candidates will take direct admission at the 3rd Semester (2nd Year) in respective Branches.
- 2) 2.1) To facilitate the students coming from diverge background through Lateral Entry Scheme and to achieve desired learning outcome of the programme the following 04 (four) nos. of bridge courses will be offered:

2.2) The bridge courses are mandatory for students taken admission through Lateral entry scheme.

2.3) The bridge courses shall be treated as non-credit courses. However, each of the candidates need to pass all the courses. The results for these courses in the form of grade will reflect at the Semester marksheet. If any student fails to qualify in any of the bridge courses, it will be considered as back paper, which shall be cleared next.

2.4) Evaluation of the courses will be same as the existing Rules & regulations'2020.

2.5) As the students admitted through lateral entry scheme is directly entered to 2nd year, the missed total of 38 Credit of the 1st year will be equalled from the percentage of marks or CGPA awarded in 2 years ITI course.
